Currently, the Falls City Backpack program services 43 elementary aged children by providing food for them to take home to be utilized over the weekend. The Backpacks are distributed by the local schools normally on Thursday each week of the school year. It has been proven there is a direct correlation between learning ability and hunger. During the week, the children receive free breakfasts and free lunches at school, but when they head home for the weekend their shelves may be bare.

Usually this time of year, SNC is preparing for the annual Empty Soup Bowls Soup Supper. While it was a difficult decision, due to COVID-19 concerns, our team has decided to cancel the event for 2021. While we are still as dedicated as ever to combating child hunger, the safety of our community comes first.

Your support is key in helping the children of Falls City by supporting the Falls City Backpack Program. It costs approximately \$250 for one student to receive weekly backpacks for an entire school year.
